- LOTW entries are 44633 with 11407 matches
- The ship qualifies for DXCC on CW, Mixed and Sideband. She is going to purchase the appropriate certificates
- Total income for QSL's is \$100.50

Chief Engineer's Report:

- There is not much going on due to the COVID restrictions
- It is possible the ship will reopen for tours on March 6
- Maintenance crews have been aboard and the teak project is progressing
- The ship has received a grant for the teak replacement and has hired two more carpenters
- Dave and Margaret are trying to recreate early volunteer files which are no longer available
- There are many jobs to do when we return. The 49 radar has been secured so that no one can mess with it. That is one of the big jobs awaiting. Also the telephone system needs a great deal of work. Dave has found a source for handset cords many of which require replacement.

Museum Ships Weekend is planned for June 5-6, 2021 tentatively a go. It will depend

on how many ships are willing to participate.

There was a discussion of the status of the "Red Phones" simulation and what needs to

be done.

Treasurer's Report:

The treasurer was not present so no report was rendered,
